Hence, the Members are requested to attend and participate at the ensuing AGM through VC / OAVM facility being provided by the Company through National Securities Depository Limited ('NSDL'). The deemed venue for the AGM shall be the Registered Office of the Company.

- The quorum for the AGM, as provided in Section 103 of the Act, is thirty (30) members (including a duly authorized representative of a body corporate) and Members present in the meeting through VC/OAVM shall be counted for the purpose of reckoning the quorum pursuant to MCA Circulars



and other applicable circulars.

The Members can join the AGM in the VC/OAVM mode 30 minutes before the scheduled time of the commencement of the AGM. The Company may close the window for joining the VC/OAVM facility 15 minutes after the scheduled time of start of the AGM. The facility of participation at the AGM through VC/OAVM will be made available for 1,000 Members on first come, first served basis. This will not include large Shareholders (Shareholders holding 2% or more shareholding), Promoters, Institutional Investors, Directors, Key Managerial Personnel, the Chairpersons of the Audit Committee, Nomination and Remuneration Committee and Stakeholders' Relationship Committee and Auditors, who are allowed to attend the AGM without restriction as provided in the MCA Circulars. Members are requested to follow the procedure stated in the "Instructions for Members for E voting and Joining the Annual General Meeting" Section of this Notice to attend the AGM Through VC/OAVM.

3. Pursuant to the provisions of the Act, a member entitled to attend and vote at the AGM is entitled to appoint a proxy to and vote on his/her behalf and the proxy need not be a Member of the Company. Since this AGM is being held pursuant to the MCA Circulars through VC / OAVM, physical attendance of Members has been dispensed with. Accordingly, the facility for appointment of proxies by the Members will not be available for the AGM and hence the Proxy Form and Attendance Slip are not annexed to this Notice.
4. The explanatory statement as required under Section 102(1) of the Companies Act, 2013 ("the Act") setting out the material facts concerning the businesses under Item No. 4 of this Notice, proposed to be transacted at the AGM is annexed hereto and forms part of this notice. The relevant details as required under Regulation 36(3) of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 and Secretarial Standard on General Meetings issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India, of the person seeking appointment/re-appointment as Director under Item No. 2 & 3 of the Notice are also annexed to the notice.
5. Institutional / Corporate Shareholders (i.e. other than individuals, HUF, NRI, etc.) are required to send a scanned copy (PDF/JPG Format) of its Board or governing body resolution/authorization etc., with attested specimen signature of the duly authorized signatory(ies) authorizing its representative to attend the AGM through VC / OAVM on its behalf and to vote through the remote e-Voting and e-Voting during AGM, to the Scrutinizer by email through its registered email address to gmadan1959@yahoo.co.in with a copy marked to cs_qftl@quadrantfuturetek.com.
6. In terms of Section 101 and 136 of the Act, read with Rules made thereunder and Regulation 36 of the SEBI LODR, as amended from time to time, the listed companies may send the financial statements (including Board's Report, Auditor's Report or other documents required to be attached therewith), Annual Report and Notice of AGM for the Financial Year ended March 31, 2026, only in electronic mode to those Members whose e-mail addresses are registered with the Company / RTA/ Depository and a letter containing the web-link for accessing, the Annual Report and the Notice of AGM for the FY 2025-26 to those shareholders who have

not registered their e-mail addresses with the Company/ RTA/Depository. The physical copies of such statements and Notice of AGM will be dispatched only to those shareholders who request the same.

7. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 108 of the Act read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 (as amended), Regulation 44 of the SEBI Listing Regulations, revised Secretarial Standards on General Meeting (SS-2) issued by the Institute of Company Secretaries of India and MCA Circulars, the Company is providing facility of remote e-Voting to its Members in respect of the business to be transacted at the AGM and facility to cast vote through e-voting system during the AGM for those Members participating in the AGM.

For this purpose, the Company has engaged NSDL for facilitating voting through electronic means, as the authorized agency. NSDL will be providing facility for voting through remote e-Voting, for participation in the 11th AGM through VC/ OAVM facility and e-Voting during the 11th AGM. Members of the Company holding shares as on the cutoff date i.e. Friday, September 18, 2026 may cast their vote either by remote e-voting or e-voting on date of AGM.

Members are requested to follow the procedure stated in the "Instructions for Members for E-Voting and Joining the Annual General Meeting" Section of this Notice to attend the AGM through VC/OAVM.

Only those Members whose names are appearing on the Register of Members / List of Beneficial Owners as on the cut-off date shall be entitled to cast their vote through remote e-voting. A person who is not a member as on the cut-off date should treat this Notice for information purpose only.

Any person who becomes a member of the Company after the dispatch of Notice and holding shares as on the Cut-off Date may obtain the login ID and password or instructions for remote e-voting by sending a request at evoting@nsdl.com or may contact at Tel. No.: (022) - 48867000.



The Members who have cast their vote by remote e-voting prior to the AGM, may also attend and participate in the proceedings of the AGM through VC/OAVM but shall not be entitled to cast their votes again. The Members can opt for only one mode of voting i.e. remote e-voting. In case of voting by both the modes, vote cast through remote e-voting will be considered as final and e-voting through VC/OAVM at AGM will not be considered. Members must note that voting by show of hands will not be available at the Meeting in terms of the aforesaid provisions.

The Resolutions set out in this Notice shall be deemed to have been passed on the date of the AGM, if approved by the requisite majority.

8. The Board of Directors, at its Meeting held on Tuesday, 11th August, 2026, has appointed M/s Girish Madan & Associates, Company Secretary in Practice, to act as the Scrutinizer for conducting the remote e-voting process as well as the e-voting system on the date of the AGM, in a fair and transparent manner.

The Scrutinizer will submit his report to the Chairman/ Managing Director/ Company Secretary after the completion of the scrutiny of the e-voting (votes cast during the AGM and votes cast through remote e-voting), within two working days from the conclusion of the AGM. The declared results along with the Scrutinizer's report shall be communicated to the stock exchanges and will also be displayed on the Company's website www.quadrantfuturetek.com. The results shall also be posted on website of NSDL at www.evoting.nsdl.com.

9. Members who would like to express their views or ask questions during the 11th AGM of the Company will be required to register themselves as a speaker by sending their request on e-mail to cs_qftl@quadrantfuturetek.com any time before 05.00 pm (IST) on Saturday, 18 September, 2026 mentioning their name, DP ID and Client ID number/folio number, email id, mobile number. Only those members who have registered as speakers till 18th September, 2026 will be permitted to speak at the meeting and their queries will be responded to responded during the AGM.

The Shareholders who do not wish to speak during the AGM but have queries may send their queries in advance 7 days prior to meeting mentioning their name, demat account number/folio number, email id, mobile number at cs_qftl@quadrantfuturetek.com. These queries will be replied to by the company suitably.

When a pre-registered speaker is invited to speak at the meeting, but he / she does not respond, the next speaker will be invited to speak. Accordingly, all speakers are requested to get connected to a device with a video/camera along with good internet speed. Please note that Members connecting from mobile devices or tablets or through laptops etc. connecting via mobile hotspot, may experience Audio/

Video loss due to fluctuation in their respective network. It is therefore recommended to use stable Wi-Fi or LAN connection to mitigate any kind of aforesaid glitches

Members desiring any information regarding the Financial Statements of the Company to be placed at the AGM are requested to write to the Company at least 7 days in advance through email on cfo@quadrantfuturetek.com with a copy marked to cs_qftl@quadrantfuturetek.com, so as to enable the management to keep the information readily available at the meeting Subject to such information being permissible to be provided.

The Company reserves the right to restrict the number of questions and number of speakers, as appropriate, for smooth conduct of the AGM. The queries may be raised precisely and in brief to enable the Company to answer the same suitably depending on the availability of time at the Meeting.

10. Members are requested to intimate changes, if any, pertaining to their name, postal address, email address, telephone/ mobile numbers, PAN, mandates, nominations, power of attorney, bank details such as, name of the bank and branch details, bank account number, MICR code, IFSC code, etc., to their Depository Participants (DPs).
11. Section 72 of the Act read with Rule 19(1) of Companies (Share Capital and Debentures) Rules, 2014, provides for the facility of nomination to security holders of the Company. This facility is mainly useful in the case of those holders who hold their shares in their own name. Investors are advised to avail of this facility to avoid any complication in the process of transmission, in case of death of the holders. Where more than one person holds the securities of a company jointly, the joint holders may together nominate, in the prescribed manner, any person to whom all the rights in the securities shall vest in the event of death of all the joint holders.

If a Member desires to opt-out or cancel the earlier nomination and record a fresh nomination, the Member may submit the same in Form ISR-3 or Form SH-14, as the case may be. The remote e-voting period begins on Tuesday, 22nd September, 2026 at 09:00 A.M. (IST) and ends on Thursday, 24th September, 2026 at 05:00 P.M. The remote e-voting module shall be disabled by NSDL for voting thereafter. The Members, whose names appear in the Register of Members / Beneficial Owners as on the record date (cut-off date) i.e. Friday, 18th September, 2026 may cast their vote electronically. The voting right of shareholders shall be in proportion to their share in the paid-up equity share capital of the Company as on the cut-off date, being Friday, 18th September, 2026.

How do I vote electronically using NSDL e-Voting system?

The way to vote electronically on NSDL e-Voting system consists of “Two Steps” which are mentioned below:

STEP 1: ACCESS TO NSDL E-VOTING SYSTEM

A) Login method for e-Voting and joining virtual meeting for Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode

In terms of SEBI circular dated December 9, 2020 on e-Voting facility provided by Listed Companies, Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode are allowed to vote through their demat account maintained with Depositories and Depository Participants. Shareholders are advised to update their mobile number and email Id in their demat accounts in order to access e-Voting facility.

B) Login Method for e-Voting and joining virtual meeting for shareholders other than Individual shareholders holding securities in demat mode and shareholders holding securities in physical mode.

How to Log-in to NSDL e-Voting website?

1. Visit the e-Voting website of NSDL. Open web browser by typing the following URL: <https://www.evoting.nsdl.com/> either on a Personal Computer or on a mobile.
2. Once the home page of e-Voting system is launched, click on the icon "Login" which is available under 'Shareholder/Member' section.
3. A new screen will open. You will have to enter your User ID, your Password/OTP and a Verification Code as shown on the screen.

Alternatively, if you are registered for NSDL eservices i.e. IDEAS, you can log-in at <https://eservices.nsdl.com/> with your existing IDEAS login. Once you log-in to NSDL eservices after using your log-in credentials, click on e-Voting and you can proceed to Step 2 i.e. Cast your vote electronically.

5. Password details for shareholders other than Individual shareholders are given below:

 - (ii) If your email ID is not registered, please follow steps mentioned below in process for those shareholders whose email ids are not registered.
6. If you are unable to retrieve or have not received the "Initial password" or have forgotten your password:
 - a) Click on "[Forgot User Details/Password?](#)" (If you are holding shares in your demat account with NSDL or CDSL) option available on www.evoting.nsdl.com.
 - b) [Physical User Reset Password?](#) (If you are holding shares in physical mode) option available on www.evoting.nsdl.com.
 - c) If you are still unable to get the password by aforesaid two options, you can send a request at evoting@nsdl.com mentioning your demat account number/folio number, your PAN, your name and your registered address etc.
 - d) Members can also use the OTP (One Time Password) based login for casting the votes on the e-Voting system of NSDL.
7. After entering your password, tick on Agree to "Terms and Conditions" by selecting on the check box.
8. Now, you will have to click on "Login" button.
9. After you click on the "Login" button, Home page of e-Voting will open.

STEP 2: CAST YOUR VOTE ELECTRONICALLY AND JOIN GENERAL MEETING ON NSDL E-VOTING SYSTEM.

How to cast your vote electronically and join General Meeting on NSDL e-Voting system?

1. After successful login at Step 1, you will be able to see all the companies "EVEN" in which you are holding shares

and whose voting cycle and General Meeting is in active status.

2. Select "EVEN" of company for which you wish to cast your vote during the remote e-Voting period and casting your vote during the General Meeting. For joining virtual meeting, you need to click on "VC/OAVM" link placed under "Join Meeting".
3. Now you are ready for e-Voting as the Voting page opens.
4. Cast your vote by selecting appropriate options i.e. assent or dissent, verify/modify the number of shares for which you wish to cast your vote and click on "Submit" and also "Confirm" when prompted.
5. Upon confirmation, the message "Vote cast successfully" will be displayed.
6. You can also take the printout of the votes cast by you by clicking on the print option on the confirmation page.
7. Once you confirm your vote on the resolution, you will not be allowed to modify your vote.

Institutional shareholders (i.e. other than individuals, HUF, NRI etc.) can also upload their Board Resolution / Power of Attorney / Authority Letter etc. by clicking on "Upload Board Resolution / Authority Letter" displayed under "e-Voting" tab in their login.
2. It is strongly recommended not to share your password with any other person and take utmost care to keep your password confidential. Login to the e-voting website will be disabled upon five unsuccessful attempts to key in the correct password. In such an event, you will need to go through the "[Forgot User Details/Password?](#)" or "[Physical User Reset Password?](#)" option available on www.evoting.nsdl.com to reset the password.
3. 2. In case shares are held in demat mode, please provide DPID-CLID (16 digit DPID + CLID or 16 Digit beneficiary ID), Name, client master or copy of Consolidated Account statement, PAN (Self attested scanned copy of PAN card), AADHAR (Self attested scanned copy of Aadhar Card) to cs_qftl@quadrantfuturetek.com with a copy marked to evoting@nsdl.com.
